In addition to our current grading system, the following is a description of a unique grade used for Spring 2020:

PCV – Pass (Covid-19 Spring 2020)

Due to the academic disruption caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, MTSU adopted a Pass/Fail Option for Spring 2020 courses. Students were allowed to select the Pass/Fail Option for individual courses.

A grade of **PCV** is not calculated into the semester or overall GPAs, but calculate in earned hours and do count toward successful completion of requirements for the major and minor, future course prerequisites, and toward graduation requirements.

Because of the disruption to instruction and the extraordinary steps required of faculty and students to complete the spring 2020 semester, no students were placed on academic suspension and Dean's List was suspended.

Students who selected Pass/Fail Option

For undergraduate courses, an A, F, or N, remain as the letter grade of record. Grades of B+, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D+, D, and D-were converted to **PCV** (Pass).

For graduate courses, an A, A-, F, remain the letter grade of record. Grades of B+, B, B-, C+, C, and C- were converted to **PCV** (Pass) and grades of D+, D, and D- were converted to F (Fail).
