- Log-off of your computer when you are away for extended periods of time.

- If you feel unsafe, or observe suspicious behavior, contact the University Police at extension 2424.
- The University Police offers [R.A.D.](#) (Rape Aggression Defense Systems) as a free, 15-hour training.
- The University Police also provides safety information on their social media accounts through Twitter and Facebook.
