Propane is a more environmentally friendly alternative to gas. Propane burns cleaner, resulting in less harmful emissions from the machine. Given volatility in gasoline prices, propane is often cheaper per gallon. Propane-operated mowers require less maintenance due to the cleaner-burning nature of the fuel.
