#### Distribution and Response Rate

October 18, 2022 –54 emails were sent to employers October 26, 2022 - A reminder was sent to all original recipients as responses were anonymous.

November 2, 2022- another reminder was sent.

November 8, 2022 – Closed the survey.

Total respondents - 24 Incomplete responses – 8 did not complete any likert-type items Response rate –16 respondents 29.6%

#### **Summary of Findings**

Responders were leaders of schools, with the majority having less than 10 years of experience.

Generally, the employers who responded believed our advanced candidates were well prepared. Areas less favorably rated were related to use of research, data and technology.

Limitations included limited response rate and inability to disaggregate data by program.
