The *Student Profiles* is published each semester and is designed to provide a common set of data to support planning, effectiveness and decision making throughout the University. It is, also, intended to provide information for responding to various surveys and other inquiries.

The highlights below are based on Fall 2005 enrollment. We welcome your comments, reactions, and suggestions as a means of improving future editions.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The University enrolled 22,554 students in the Fall semester.
- Seventy-eight (78) percent of all students enrolled are full-time and twenty-two (22) percent are part-time.
- Undergraduates represent ninety (90) percent and graduates represent ten (10) percent of our total enrollment.
- Ninety-three (93) percent of all students are residents of Tennessee.
- Minority students represent eighteen (18) percent of the University's enrollment.
- Women are a majority at the University, accounting for fifty-four (54) percent of enrollment.
- Enrollment of adult learners is 9,127 which constitutes forty (40) percent of our total enrollment.
- Enrollment of 11,352 evening students represents fifty (50) percent of the student body; of the evening students 9,843 (87%) are undergraduate and 1,509 (13%) are graduate students.
- A total of 4,852 students take classes via alternative delivery methods. These students, which represent 22% percent of our total student enrollment, generate a total of 14,334 credit hours.
- The average age of our students is 24.
