The highlights below are based on Fall 2009 enrollment. We welcome your comments, reactions, and suggestions as a means of improving future editions.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The University enrolled 25,188 students in the Fall semester.
- Seventy-six (76) percent of all students enrolled are full-time and twenty-four (24) percent are part-time.
- Undergraduates represent eighty-nine (89) percent and graduates represent eleven (11) percent of our total enrollment.
- Ninety-four (94) percent of all students are residents of Tennessee.
- Minority students represent twenty-two (22) percent of the University's enrollment.
- Women are a majority at the University, accounting for fifty-three (53) percent of enrollment.
- Enrollment of adult learners is 10,472 which constitutes forty-two (42) percent of our total enrollment.
- Enrollment of 13,088 evening students represents fifty-two (52) percent of the student body; of the evening students 11,393 (87%) are undergraduate and 1,695 (13%) are graduate students.
- A total of 8,075 students take classes via alternative delivery methods. These students, which represent thirty-two (32) percent of our total student enrollment, generate a total of 23,539 credit hours.
- The average age of our students is 24.
