Pursuant to 34 CFR §668.43, Middle Tennessee State University (MTSU) provides the following disclosure related to the educational requirements for professional licensure and certification necessary for employment in Tennessee.

The educational requirements for certification as a Certified Psychological Assistant in Tennessee are a minimum of 33 semester hours of graduate coursework from an accredited institution in a program designed to educate and train Certified Psychological Assistants. MTSU is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC). Successful completion of the Master of Arts in Psychology, Clinical (MA Psychology, Clinical) in the College of Behavioral and Health Sciences meets the educational requirements. Admission to the program does not guarantee that students will obtain a license or certification.

The table beginning on page two of this disclosure indicates the states and territories where MTSU has determined, through reasonable, good faith effort, that the MA Psychology, Clinical does or does not meet the educational requirements to sit for the obtain licensure or certification as a Certified Psychological Assistant where required. Licensing authorities for each state set and enforce their own requirements and standards, which are subject to change. State requirements may include additional and recurring requirements, such as an application, supervision, examinations, continuing education, fees, fingerprinting, a background check, etc. MTSU strongly recommends that prospective and current students not located in Tennessee or who plan to seek licensure or certification outside the state of Tennessee consult the licensure guide published by the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB) and contact the appropriate state licensing agency or board before enrolling in the program. Students should discuss their plans with an advisor to ensure they have the most up-to-date information and guidance regarding licensure or registration requirements.
