四种干预的方法(4D法)

当您看到或遇到一个潜在的不安全的情况时......

Direct 直接 介入干涉并直接解决问题

例如: "您的行为很不妥当。请停止。"或"嘿,请离开他们。"

Distract 分散注意 创造一个场景来使任何潜在"施暴者"分心以便控制局面

例如: "嘿,我们是不是西班牙语课的同学?"

Delegate 委托 找一个可以帮助你干预的人

示例: 您可以联系学校的宿管、校园警察或教职员工。

Delay 拖延 拖延几分钟有利于推迟甚至阻止恶果的发生

示例: 如果您和受害者同在一个小组中, 您可以通过要求同此人一起去洗手间来拖延时间。
