## Fall 2023 Statistical Notes:

-The Fall 2023 headcount is 20,183 which is an increase over last year's headcount of 20,086 and FTE is $16,178.40$ which is an increase over last year's FTE of $16,075.88$.
-The Fall 2023 Freshman class average high school GPA (3.65) is above last year's freshman class (3.63). The average ACT of 22.52 is above both the 2022 national average (19.8) and Tennessee tested
population average (18.6) as well as the 2021 national average (20.3) and Tennessee average (19.1). This year's 2023 ACT National and State averages will not be available until late-October.
-Undergraduate population $(17,668)$ equals $87.5 \%$ of total enrollment and graduate population $(2,515)$ equals $12.5 \%$ of total enrollment
 -Transfer students enrolled $(9,598)$ represent $54.3 \%$ of the total undergraduate population
-Hispanic enrollment $(1,825)$ represents $9.04 \%$ of the total enrollment. Asian enrollment $(1,325)$ represents $6.56 \%$ of the total enrollment
-African-American enrollment $(3,304)$ represents $16.37 \%$ of total enrollment. African-American first time freshmen $(538)$ is $17.42 \%$ of total first-time freshmen $(3,088)$
Undergraduate African-American (2,858) is $16.18 \%$ of total undergraduate enrollment (17,668). Graduate African-American ( 446 ) is $17.73 \%$ of total graduate enrollment $(2,515)$.
-Female enrollment is 10,806 or $53.54 \%$ of total; male enrollment is 9,377 or $46.46 \%$ of total.
-Concurrent High School enrollment (1,173 new, 269 returnees) represents 33 high schools and 9 home/umbrella schools, is $8.16 \%$ of the total undergraduate population.
-Concurrent High School enrollment across 2 semesters with credit occurring in the Spring 2024 for science/math related courses represents 2 high schools and 67 students with zero credit only this semester.
