

SGA Resolution No. 16-04-F

A Resolution to increase campus security by installing more lights on specific areas of the campus.

Whereas: The pathway between Peck Hall and the KUC as well as the area around the JUB, Todd, and KOM is not as well lit as the quad, and

Whereas: None of the bus stops have lights in them, and this potentially creates an unsafe situation for those who wait for the bus at night, and

Whereas: There is not an adequate number of blue lights on specific areas of campus, namely the older part of campus, the pathway between the Recreation Center and Greek Row, and at the bus stops,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 67TH CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MTSU THAT:

Section 1: More pathway lights be installed between Peck Hall and the KUC as well as around the area of the JUB, Todd, and KOM.

Section 2: Regular lights be installed overhead or around each of the bus stops on campus.

Section 3: At least 2 or 3 blue lights be installed on the pathway between the Recreation Center and Greek Row.

Section 4: A blue light is installed at each of the bus stops on campus.
