

SGA Resolution 8-06-F

A Resolution to implement a “dead period” requiring an allotted time on a weekday where no classes take place, so that student activities may be allowed to meet on campus.

Whereas: Student organizations have meetings late in the evening, which often deters students from attending,

Whereas: Due to transportation distance, commuter students do not have the same leisure time as students who live on campus,

Whereas: Allotting a time for students to meet would increase participation in student activities,

Whereas: Increased participation in student activities would increase school spirit and morale,

Whereas: All classrooms would be open during the “dead period”, allowing ample use of facilities for student activities to meet,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 69TH SGA CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MTSU THAT:


Section 1: The “dead period” should not exceed one hour so that educational opportunities are not sacrificed.

Section 2: In order to fully utilize the time allotted, the “dead period” hour should be implemented on a weekday, Monday through Friday.

Section 3: The scheduling department should not implement the “dead period” before 10:00 AM in the morning or after 4:00 PM in the afternoon.

Section 4: “Dead Periods” should take place no more than four times per semester and no less than two times per semester.
