

SGA BILL 9-11-S

A bill to remove COSGA from the SGA Bylaws, Article XII, Section I, and insert ASGA

Whereas: The Student Government Association of MTSU is no longer a part of COSGA.

Whereas: MTSU is now a part of the American Student Government Association

Whereas: Errors in our bylaws must be fixed to ensure consistency.

Therefore let it be resolved by the 73rd Congress of the Student Government Association of Middle Tennessee State University that:

Section 1: COSGA be removed from the SGA bylaws, Article XII, Section 1 and ASGA be inserted.

Section 2: Section 1 will read as follows:

“Section 1: The American Student Government Association is the nation’s professional association serving and supporting Student Government members, leaders and advisors. Conferences provided by this association are vital in the further development and success of the Student Government Association.

A. Up to eight members of the Student Government Association shall be sent to an ASGA conference each year. Participants will be selected using the following criteria:

1. To be considered, participants must be current members of the Executive Branch, the Cabinet, or the Senate.
2. Members of the Executive Branch will receive priority over the other interested students.
3. No participant shall have attended an ASGA conference more than twice in the past.
4. No more than three participants for the current year may have attended an ASGA conference in the past.
5. Participants must have at least one semester prior involvement with SGA.”
