

SGA Bill 6-18-S

A Bill to Update the Governing Documents and their References to the Constitution

Whereas: SGA is in the process of updating the SGA Constitution.

Whereas: Some information in the SGA Constitution has moved sections.

Whereas: SGA's governing documents reference this information.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 80TH CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: The SGA Electoral Act shall be amended in the following ways:

- A. The reference in the Purpose shall say, "Article 2, Section 2."
- B. Article II, Section 9 shall say, "Qualifications of office for executive board members are listed in the SGA Constitution Article IV, Section 1 and qualifications of office for senators are listed in the SGA Constitution Article V, Section 4."
- C. The By-Laws reference in Article V, Section 2 shall say, "Article 12."
- D. The By-Laws reference in Article X, Section 3 shall say, "Article 5, Section 6."

Section 2: The Constitution of the Freshman Council shall be amended in the following ways:


- A. The reference in Article V, Section 2, subsection b shall say, "Article 5, Section 8."


