Section 1: The James E. Walker Library shall install a publicly accessible "Student Convenience Stall" in the library at a location the concerning University staff member(s) see most fit.


Section 2: "Student Convenience Stall" shall be defined as: a space for students to prepare food which includes but is not limited to:
