

**SGA Resolution 5-15-S**

**A Resolution to Install a Big Belly Solar Trash Compactor at Middle Tennessee State University**

- Whereas:** Installation of another compactor would benefit the MTSU community by being a visible, environmentally friendly solution to trash overflow;
- Whereas:** Big Belly compactors are far more aesthetic than the traditional outdoor trash bin;
- Whereas:** Installation of another compactor would reduce Custodial Services workload, while decreasing the volume of waste entering the Middle Point Landfill;
- Whereas:** The current compactors on campus have been an indirect benefit for SGA public relations.

**THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 78<sup>th</sup> CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:**

- Section 1:** MTSU Facilities Services will install a single-unit Big Belly Solar Trash compactor in one of two locations: North face of the John Bragg Mass Communication building, or North face of the Science building.
- Section 2:** This resolution will be funded by a proposal to the MTSU Sustainable Campus Fee Funding Program.
- Section 3:** This resolution will go into effect immediately upon favorable passage.
