Details:

Amount of the scholarships: \$300.00 per semester. For the most part, the intention of the scholarship is to pay for textbook expenses.

Who is eligible to apply: Those who will be junior or senior social work students at MTSU in the next year of their studies. All applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Criteria that will determine who will be awarded Dale Robert Seime Scholarship. The three most important factors will be:

- a. <u>Commitment to the field of medical social work.</u>
- b. <u>Scholarship</u>. Overall GPA as well as grades in courses related to social work will be indicators of scholarship.
- c. <u>Financial need</u>. Insufficient income, need to terminate employment or not engage in employment during their studies, child care expenses as well as other expenses are indicators of need.

A person is eligible to receive the scholarship for no more than one academic year (fall and spring semester).
