## This week's e-mail focuses on communication strategies and best practices in your courses.



"In May-June 2020, the Jones College Dean's Office conducted a survey of Jones College undergraduate students regarding the shift to remote learning caused by the COVID-19 crisis during Spring 2020. Overall, one factor was most important in classes that fell short of expectations, in classes that met expectations, and in hypothetical ideal/perfect classes: the professor..... The survey results also highlight the fact that instructors can take action, and that action can positively affect the way that students view the quality of the course..... One thing that instructors can do is to raise the frequency and quality of communication with students."
