



Number of "Completed" Surveys Vs Total Number "Started"






What is your primary role in relation to MTSU? (Check one)




Figure 1. Disagree or Strongly Disagree: All Role-Type




Figure 2. Three words or phrases in the current mission statement are most important to you?




Figure 3. Missing from current mission statement




Figure 4. Three words you want to see in the revised MTSU mission statement




Figure 5. Three words or phrases in the current vision statement are most important to you




Figure 6. Missing from current vision statement




Figure 7. Three words you want to see in the revised MTSU vision statement

Overview

This analysis of the survey data offers a limited view of information, and hopefully it serves as an icebreaker to fine tune further research on this topic. This section briefly summarizes several takeaways to help guide the next steps in the committee's process.

- Explain who MTSU serves is an area for improvement—nearly 30% of responses were neutral to strongly disagree.
- The current mission statement does a better job of *explaining what MTSU is* and *what MTSU does* and why—between 17% 20% of responses were neutral to strongly disagree.
- o UG students and alumni responded at the highest rate and accounted for 51.3% of all responses.
- o Overall, students accounted for 28.4% of all responses (UG and GR).
- Faculty accounted for 18.5% of all responses.
- o Administrative and classified staff made up 19.7% of all responses.

Emerging Themes

An examination of term frequencies for the three sets of questions regarding the mission statement and vision statement points to the emergences of a few broad themes: community, students, diversity/inclusion, and excellence/quality. These themes require further exploration and defining since the terms can have different meanings across groups. The concept of community is an excellent example and may be conceptualized differently from the perspective of a student or alumni—what core values bind it together, and who does it include or exclude.

Descriptive Breakdown

Table 2 provides insight into the number of responses for each open-ended question on the Mission Review Survey. The counts represent the number of records with non-blank cells for each question. Most respondents provided feedback for questions related to what was most important to them for both the mission statement (n=993) and vision statement (n=820). In contrast, they were less likely to provide feedback on what they wanted to see in the revised statements: 351 and 302, respectively. Nevertheless, the response level was substantial enough to help drive the conversation at hand.

Dissenting Viewpoints

Figure 1 through Figure 3 represent survey takers who responded either "strongly disagree" or "disagree' (SD/D) to the three scaled questions: "Does the current MTSU Mission Statement...". This group made up a small

portion of overall responders. The responses were further broken down by role-type, and responses without an identified role were excluded prior to calculating the distribution rate. For *Explain*, 70 out of the 1489 (4.7%) responses were SD/D. Of this group, Full-time faculty (34.3%) and Alumni (22.9%) were more likely to disagree. Similar sentiments emerged for *Describe* (92 out of 1471 responses, or 6.3%) and *Serve* (167 out of 1461 responses, or 11.4%).

Term Frequency by Role-Type

This section provides the term frequency breakdown for each role-type. It provides a similar view to Table 1 where the distribution reflects an aggregated count. The count for each term is divided by the aggregate term count in Table 1 to get the percent by role-type. The following are a few takeaways.

Most Frequent Terms

- The term *diverse* appeared most frequently among Alumni(n=117, 25.7%), Full-time Faculty (n=103, 22.6%), Administrative Staff (n=92, 20.2%), and UG Student (n=73, 16.0%). [M1]
- Innovative was referenced most often among Alumni(n=135, 31.7%), Administrative Staff (n=85, 20.0%), Full-time Faculty (n=82, 19.2%), and UG student (n=54, 12.7%) [M1]
- Alumni mentioned *community* 34 times (29.1%): Full-time Faculty (n=30, 25.6%), Administrative Staff (n=20, 17.5%), UG Student (n=18, 15.4%)[M2]
- Full-time Faculty (n=23, 35.9%), Administrative Staff (n=13, 20.3%), and UG Student (n=11, 17.2%) listed Community most frequently for [M3]
- The term *quality* appeared most frequently among Alumni(n=134, 29.3%), Full-time Faculty (n=117, 25.5%), Administrative Staff (n=94, 20.5%), and UG Student (n=53, 11.6%). [V1]

Unique Terms

- ➤ Graduates had unique terms in [M1] that included *prepare*, *research*, *and persevere*: [M2] counts were less than three—it seems this group left a lot of blank rows.
- Graduates and Community Members were the only two groups not to mention community for [M2]
