## Middle Tennessee State University Regional Scholars Program Undergraduate Registration and Mandatory Fees

## Per Semester Fall 2024 or Spring 2025

All fees are subject to change by the Board of Trustees. Charges for all course work will be assessed by STUDENT level. The University reserves the right to correct errors in student fee assessments and charges which are discovered subsequent to initial billings or fee statements.

The Regional Scholars Program is available to students who are classified as non-residents of Tennessee who live within approximately 250 miles of MTSU **OR** live anywhere within the eight states bordering Tennessee (Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina and Virginia).

To qualify for a reduced rate, the student must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Graduated from a high school located in a county within a 250 mile radius of MTSU or from one of the eight contiguous states listed above.
- 2. Have an ACT composite of 25 (SAT equivalent) or above
  - a. Prior to March 2016 SAT score of 1130 (Critical Reading & Math)
  - b. March 2016 and future tests SAT score of 1200 (Critical Reading & Math)
- 3. Attend full time (at least 12 hours)
- 4. Apply for the Academic Common market program (if available)

NOTE: If at any point (before or during the semester), a Regional Scholar who drops below full-time status (below 12 credit hours) will be charged the full out-of-state tuition rate.
